

Crouch Bowling Club

The lottery

Each month we run a Private Society Lottery (known as "200 Club") for all Members of the Crouch Bowling Club, excluding the general public.

The Draw

The Draw will normally take place at the Clubhouse towards the end of each month to coincide with a Social Evening or Bowls Match. If this is not possible, the Treasurer will carry out the draw at home with a responsible family member. Numbers are chosen randomly.

Prizes

Allocation of the prize money is as follows: 70% of that months' income goes to participating winning Members, with the remaining 30% being donated to Club Funds. Each individual member may have as many entries as they would like.

- EG: If 100 entries @ £5 are received, it would give a total of £500.
- ➤ Prizes would then be allocated: 1st £200, 2nd £100 and 3rd £50, with £150 going to Club Funds. The figures would be adjusted pro-rota up or down depending on the number of entries received that month.

How to Join

There are three ways to join the Lottery:

- Set up a Standing Order for £5 per month per entry from your own Bank Account to Crouch Bowling Club (HSBC Sort Code 40 40 25, Account 01447742), quoting your Name followed by 200, as the reference. You can cancel anytime, just provide two months' notice, to the Treasurer.
- 2. Make a one-off Bank Transfer of £60 per entry, per year, using the details above.
- 3. Make a one-off payment of £60 per entry, per year, by Cheque (payable to Crouch Bowling Club) or Cash to the Treasurer. (This method will attract a small Bank Charge for depositing "over the counter").
